

Seasons in Belize

March-May is considered the Dry Season. During this time of year the temperature is extremely hot and humid. Lightweight, breathable, wicking (fast dry) material is suggested for this season. Items like these can be found at outdoor/sports stores like Dicks, REI, etc. The days are typically hot but the nights can still get chilly, so it is recommended to bring a sweatshirt and pants.

Clothing items to bring:

Women: T-shirts (both nice and ones that can get dirty), tank tops (no spaghetti straps, strapless or halter tops), capris, Bermuda shorts, athletic shorts (knee length), a pair of jeans or athletic pants, lightweight jacket/sweatshirt, a long-sleeve shirt, swimsuit (modest one-piece with swim shorts/skirt, tankini that fully conceals the midriff, two-piece with a dark tank-top and swim shorts/skirt, church attire (skirt or dress knee-length or longer with a casual top), tennis shoes, water shoes, sandals, church-appropriate shoes

Men: T-shirts (both nice and ones that can get dirty), a long-sleeve shirt, a lightweight jacket/sweatshirt, athletic shorts, jean and/or khaki shorts, a pair of jeans or athletic pants, church-appropriate attire (nice shirt and nice pants/shorts), swimsuit (no speedo or low-rise trunks—if low-rise you must wear boxer shorts underneath), tennis shoes, water shoes, sandals, church-appropriate shoes

June-September is considered the Rainy Season. During this time of year the temperature is hot and humid and it will usually rain every day. Clothes and shoes will get muddy. It is suggested to bring a raincoat, umbrella, and material that dries easily. A lightweight jacket is recommended in case of abnormal cool nights.

Clothing items to bring:

Women: T-shirts (both nice and ones that can get dirty), tank tops (no spaghetti straps, strapless or halter tops), capris, Bermuda shorts, athletic shorts (knee length), a pair of jeans or athletic pants, lightweight jacket/sweatshirt, swimsuit (modest one-piece with swim shorts/skirt, tankini that fully conceals the midriff, two-piece with a dark tank-top and swim shorts/skirt, church attire (skirt or dress knee-length or longer with a casual top), tennis shoes, water shoes, sandals, church-appropriate shoes, raincoat

Men: T-shirts (both nice and ones that can get dirty), a lightweight jacket/sweatshirt, athletic shorts, jean and/or khaki shorts, a pair of jeans or athletic pants, church-appropriate attire (nice shirt and nice pants/shorts), swimsuit (no speedo or low-rise trunks—if low-rise you must wear boxer shorts underneath), tennis shoes, water shoes, sandals, church-appropriate shoes

October-January is considered the Winter Season. During this time of year the temperature can still be hot, but there are cool days and the temperature drops in the night and early morning; it rains occasionally. It is suggested to bring a few pair of pants, multiple pairs of socks, a lightweight jacket/sweatshirt, long sleeve shirts and possibly even an extra blanket to keep you warm during sleeping.

Clothing items to bring:

Women: T-shirts (both nice and ones that can get dirty), tank tops (no spaghetti straps, strapless or halter tops), capris, Bermuda shorts, athletic shorts (knee length), jeans or athletic pants, long-sleeved shirts, sweaters, lightweight jacket/sweatshirt, swimsuit (modest one-piece with swim shorts/skirt, tankini that fully conceals the midriff, two-piece with a dark tank-top and swim shorts/skirt, church attire (skirt or dress knee-

length or longer with a casual top), tennis shoes, water shoes, sandals, church-appropriate shoes, house slippers raincoat

Men: T-shirts (both nice and ones that can get dirty), a lightweight jacket/sweatshirt, long-sleeved shirts, athletic shorts, jean and/or khaki shorts, jeans or athletic pants, church-appropriate attire (nice shirt and nice pants/shorts), swimsuit (no speedo or low-rise trunks—if low-rise you must wear boxer shorts underneath), tennis shoes, water shoes, sandals, church-appropriate shoes, raincoat

February is considered the transition month from Winter Season to Dry Season. The temperature can vary greatly: it ranges from weather similar to the October-January months and the March-May months, so be prepared to bring clothing found in each category. The temperature doesn't get as cool as the Winter Season, and doesn't get as hot as the Dry season, but it is definitely still hot weather.

Clothing items to bring:

Women: T-shirts (both nice and ones that can get dirty), tank tops (no spaghetti straps, strapless or halter tops), capris, Bermuda shorts, athletic shorts (knee length), a pair of jeans or athletic pants, lightweight jacket/sweatshirt, swimsuit (modest one-piece with swim shorts/skirt, tankini that fully conceals the midriff, two-piece with a dark tank-top and swim shorts/skirt, church attire (skirt or dress knee-length or longer with a casual top), tennis shoes, water shoes, sandals, church-appropriate shoes, raincoat
